The entire undersea kingdom is busy with preparations for Murmur's big day: King Neptune is busy preparing a proclamation, Granny is making a good luck charm bracelet, Minnowmaid, Murmur's older sister, is making tasty candies for her trip and the Sea Urchin, the King's majordomo, is trying to keep everything in order without losing his sanity. The big day finally arrives and the undersea kingdom gives Murmur a grand send-off. At the top of the sea, Murmur meets the painfully shy, but quietly funny Ollie, reluctantly in training to be the King, and not exactly Murmur's idea of Prince Charming. Their ensuing friendship and Ollie's insecurity prompts Murmur to seek out the help of the Sea Witch. The Sea Witch has been plotting with her henchmen, Turt, a silly turtle, and Tort, a villainous tortoise, to capture Murmur's magical voice in an evil scheme to rob the coronation ships of their treasure. When Murmur sings, it puts all who listen to her in a magical trance—perfect for the Sea Witch's plot!!! The chorus of this show is made up of jelly fish, shimmying seaweed, sharks, stingrays, octopus and other brightly colored sea creatures. This charming retelling of Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tale is a definite audience pleaser with it's larger-than-life characters, lively calypso dance numbers and it's fantastical underwater setting. This musical also has a wonderful message to believe in yourself and embrace your uniqueness.
